Background

KWWA is pleased to announce a new Grant program, supported by the WA Department of Local Government, Sport, and Cultural Industries, and by Kung Fu Wushu Australia. A Grant of up to **\$500** will be available to those members of Kung Fu Wushu Western Australia participating in IWUF recognised events and will be used to assist athletes, coaches and managers meet the financial burdens associated with their progression to achieve standards of excellence in the sport of Kung Fu and Wushu.

Who is eligible?

In order to be eligible to apply for a Grant, applicants must -

- Be a resident of Western Australia
- Be an Australian Citizen with an Australian Passport
- Be participating as an athlete, coach or manager at an internationally recognised IWUF event as a representative of Australia or as a member of an official KWA Australian team
- Not be participating in a professional competition that involves prizemoney.

What type of event is ineligible for a grant?

Participation in the following events will not be considered for a grant:

- Ongoing seasonal competitions
- Friendship or invitational events
- Country or regional competitions

Application Process

- Applications must be submitted on the official KWWA Event Grant application form and accompanied by other essential documentation as advised.
- Applications must be submitted no later than the closing date provided. Applications received after the notified closing date may not be accepted.
- Assessment of applications will be carried out by a Judging Panel of the KWWA executive committee.

- Assessment of application forms will include verification of the applicant's performances at a representative level at any State, National or International level over the previous two (2) year period.
- Applicants will be notified if they were successful or unsuccessful in receiving a grant.
- The Judging Panel reserves the right not to award a Grant in any year depending on the overall quality – level of applications received.
- The decisions of the Judging Panel are final and not open to appeal.

Roles and Responsibilities of the successful applicant

The successful applicant must adhere to the following;

- Respect the integrity of sport in accordance with the National Body's Code of Conduct and be encouraged to report unethical behaviour,
- including instances of doping, competition manipulation, prohibited discrimination and abuse and harassment.
- Comply with applicable national laws, and the rules of the qualification processes and competitions, of the sport, and of the relevant sporting organisation.
- Act as a role model, including by promoting clean sport.
- Inform themselves and be aware of their responsibilities.

- 1. Applications must be received by no later than close of business on Friday 14th June 2019.***
- 2. Submissions received after this date may not be considered by the Judging Panel.***
- 3. Applications should be emailed or mailed to the KWWA Executive Committee complete with all essential and supporting documentation.***
- 4. Incomplete applications will not be considered.***
